IMPORTANT: What You Need to Bring

PASSPORTS FOR EVERYONE IN YOUR BOAT - Half Moon Island is in the United States, so valid passports are required for all passengers, including children.

Getting to the Picnic

- 1. Load your boat with everyone attending and ensure all passengers have their passports
- 2. Drive your boat directly to Half Moon Island on East Grand Lake
- 3. Meet the US Border Agent who will be stationed on-site at the island
- 4. Present all passports to the US Border Agent for review and check-in
- 5. Enjoy the picnic!

CRITICAL: You MUST check back into Canada or risk illegal entry charges!

Leaving the Picnic - MANDATORY STEP

- 1. Drive your boat to the Canadian Border Dock (located just before the bridge on the Canadian side of the Orient/Fosterville border crossing)
- 2. Have ONE person go to the border office with ALL passports from your group
- 3. Check in with Canadian Border Services they are aware of the picnic and expecting attendees
- 4. Complete your check-in before heading home

Important Reminders:

- Bring passports for everyone
- Check in with US Border Agent at the island
- Check back in with Canadian Border Services upon leaving the Island
